<p><b>Finance</b> - Leaders who work in establishments primarily engaged in financial transactions (transactions involving the creation, liquidation, or change in ownership of financial assets) and/or in facilitating financial transactions. <p><b>Government</b> - Leaders who work in local, state, or national governments or are part of public administration.</p>	7%
<p><b>Healthcare</b> - Leaders who work in establishments primarily engaged in providing healthcare services and equipment. These establishments include hospitals, private medical practices, and medical equipment suppliers.</p>	8%
<p><b>Manufacturing</b> - Leaders who work in establishments involved in the making of goods by manual labor (e.g., automotive factory) and establishments engaged in the discovery, development, and manufacture of drugs and medications.</p>	11%
<p><b>Non-Profit</b> - Leaders who work in establishments formed to provide public benefit without a focus on profit or gain. These establishments include community foundations and private charitable organizations.</p>	6%
<p><b>Professional Services</b> - Leaders who work in establishments primarily engaged in providing specialist business support and support to individuals. This can include Accounting, Coaching/Consulting, Financial, IT, Legal, Recruitment, Training, and other advice.</p>	12%
<p><b>Technology</b> - Leaders who work in establishments that specialize in performing scientific and technical activities and experimentation that produce new ideas and products that others can use. Examples of these establishments include biotechnology firms and software producers.</p>	12%
<p><b>Other</b> - Leaders working in all other industries such as retail, food and beverage, transportation, etc.</p>	15%
